15518 MARGARET ANN TAPLEY (1825 - 1901)

Margaret Ann TAPLEY was born at Vlissingen, Holland, and baptised there on 7 November 1825. Her father was Thomas TAPLEY (1789 - 1856) a baker, and her mother was Mary TAPLEY, nee MORFORD (1791 - 1867).¹

The family later moved to Rotterdam, and in the mid 1830s back to England just prior to emigration to South Australia in 1838. They embarked on the ship RAJASTHAN in July 1838, and arrived in South Australia on 16 November 1838. They settled at what became known as Tapleys Hill. ²

In 1841, Margaret Ann, aged 16 years, was listed with the family in the Census of that year, which listed her as under 21 years. ³

Margaret was a witness at the marriage of her sister Elizabeth to George Henry SHARPE on 24 August 1848, at the Freeman Street Congregational Chapel, Adelaide. 4

Once more, Margaret was a witness to the marriage of her younger sister, Mary Jane TAPLEY, to John Frederick SCHRAMM, on 18 August 1852, at Christ Church (Anglican) Chapel, O'Halloran Hill. 5

On 28 September 1854, Margaret witnessed the marriage of her brother James Morford TAPLEY to Mary SHARPE, at Christ Church Chapel, O'Halloran Hill. 6

Margaret Ann TAPLEY, by now aged 29 years, was married on 11 July 1855, at Trinity Church, Adelaide. She married a German farmer, Christian SAUERBIER, aged 41 years. The marriage was conducted by the Rev. R. STRONG, and witnesses to her marriage were Thomas TAPLEY, J. A. TAPLEY, Richard Mordaunt TAPLEY, and Hannah TAPLEY. 7

Her husband was a Farmer at Happy Valley, not far from The TAPLEY farm.

Over the ensuing years they were to have five children as follows -

155181 - John Christian SAUERBIER, born 4 September 1856 at Happy Valley.

155182 - John James SAUERBIER, born 10 February 1858, at Happy Valley.

155183 - George SAUERBIER, born 3 January 1860 at Happy Valley.

155184 - Mary Elizabeth SAUERBIER, born 20 September 1863, but who died 8 August 1864.

155185 - Mary Elizabeth SAUERBIER, born 26 September 1865, who unfortunately also died the following year on 15 March 1866. 8

They did not have any more children after the loss of this last child in 1866.

Her husband, Christian, died at Happy Valley on 21 October 1893 of heart disease. 9

Margaret continued to live at Happy Valley after the death of her husband, but she died at New Parkside, South Australia on 23 July 1901. This may have been at her younger sister Hannah's home at Parkside. Hannah had married Christian's brother John. The cause of death was listed on her death certificate as glycosuria, and exhaustion. She was 76 years of age. The Undertaker, D. SPENCER of Darlington, was the Informant to the Registrar's office. Margaret Ann SAUERBIER, nee TAPLEY is buried with her husband in the Happy Valley Cemetery. 10

CHRISTIAN SAUERBIER (1814-1893)

Christian SAUERBIER was born on 23 March 1814 at Butzbach, Hesse, Darmstadt, Germany. His father was Gerhard SAUERBIER. Mother's name not known at present. 1

He had a brother Johannes (John), and they grew up in Germany. Christian emigrated to Australia, probably in the 1830s, and arrived overland in Sydney, New South Wales in January of 1840. 2

In Sydney, Christian established a Bakery, and was listed in the City of Sydney Directory of 1844-45

as-
 Sauerbier Christian, baker, 642 George Street 3

His brother Johannes joined him in this venture sometime during the 1840s in Sydney. This brother, married a widow in 1848, whose name was Dorate DEBUS. She may have been the widow of a C. DEBUS who in 1842 was recorded as being a landowner at Happy Valley, in South Australia.

In 1849, at the age of 35 years Christian was naturalized in Sydney as an Australian citizen.

".. having arrived in Sydney in the in January 1840 he is now residing in Sydney and carrying on a living as a baker and being beneficially entitled to and Heriditament in NSW" 4

There are records of him to South Australia and back several times during this period in Sydney. He may have purchased the land at Happy Valley initially from Dorate DEBUS, and this is why he travelled to South Australia.

In 1853, Christian took up residence in South Australia, settling at Happy Valley where he had a farming property. 5

He would have been a relatively near neighbour of the Tapley Family of Tapley's Hill. Christian was 41 years of age when on 11 July 1855 he married Margaret Ann TAPLEY at Trinity Church Adelaide. 6

By 1856, Christian was expanding his land holdings and was the owner of Sections 256, 278, 279, 280, 281, 476, 495, 504, 790, 798, and 799 in the Happy Valley area in the district of Clarendon. 7

Christian and Margaret had the following children over the years -

1. John Christian , born 4 September 1856.
2. John James , born 10 Feb 1858.

3. George, born 3 January 1860.
4. Mary Elizabeth, born 20 September 1863, and died 8 August 1864.
5. Mary Elizabeth, born 26 September 1865, and died 15 March 1866.8

In the 1870s, Christian built a new family home at Happy Valley Estate (now known as Aberfoyle Park). The property consisted of a homestead and associated stable, barn and groomsmen's quarters, as well as a number of other structures. The house is built into the hill, and is constructed of bluestone rubble with brick dressings, and is set over a substantial basement. The hipped roof incorporated a concave corrugated galvanized iron clad verandah which encircles the building. 9

On 6 September 1883, Christian was naturalized in South Australia at the age of 69 years, and had resided in South Australia at that time for 30 years. 10

By 1890, Christian was listed as owning the following property as listed in the Clarendon District Council Assessment Records

HAPPY VALLEY - 792, 256, 476, 495, 504, 276, 277, 280, 281, 278, 279, 790, 791, 798, 799, 78, 72, 503.
CLARENDON - 676, 677, 686.

WICKHAM HILL - 717, 720, 502. 11

During the years 1891, and 1892, some of his land was acquired by the South Australian government to build the Happy Valley Reservoir. 12

Christian died on 21 October 1893, at the age of 79 years at Happy Valley. He died of heart disease and dysentery. The informant was his son John James SAUERBIER of Happy Valley. The death was registered at the District of Morphett Vale on 28 October 1893 with James CHAFFER, the District Registrar.13

He was survived by his wife and 3 sons.

* His brother Johannes also was a Baker of George Street.

* Travelled back and forth to South Australia several times.

* Moved to South Australia in 1853. Took Up land at Happy Valley. This may have been the land formerly owned by his sister in law, Dorate DEBUS. See under DEBUS family below for mention of Christian DEBUS at Happy Valley.

DEBUS FAMILY

* Dorate was born Margaretha Dorothea Elizabeth RUHRER at Lubeck, Germany in 1803.

* Dorate married in 1828 to Johann Christian Philip DEBUS in Gussln, Germany.

* They had a son Henry DEBUS. This son is the Grandfather of Margo Wagner of Sydney, NSW.

* They also had a daughter Anna Maria DEBUS.

Anna Maria DEBUS Married at the age of 24 years on 27 September 1855 to Charles ANABALDI. (Anna born 1831).

"In 1842, Henry DUGLASS(sic) and C. DEBUS were, according to Bennett's Almanack, situated at Happy Valley, while Cotter's Almanack of 1843 expanded this to include Duthy and Stout with Tapley at Tapley's Hill and Thomas Ware at O'Halloran Hill. Allen's Almanack of 1844 gives a clearer description of landholders and activities in the Happy Valley area. The list reproduced as part of the Appendices is not a complete copy from Allen, but an abstraction of the more directly relevant names. It can be seen that Burgess, Morphett, Chandler, DEBUS, Douglas, and Tapley were by this time well established..."

Brief description and history: Christian Sauerbier first took up land in the Happy Valley area in the early 1850s.

Sauerbier is noted in the 1856 Clarendon District Council Rate Assessment Books as holding Sections 790, 792, 476, 256, 504, 495, 798, 280, 281, 279, 278. Section 792 contained a cottage and garden, while on Section 495 a hut had been erected.

While Taylors Road, near which the complex is situated commemorates a subsequent owner of this property, the present name of the whole area `Aberfoyle Park' acknowledges a member of the Sauerbier family, John Christian Sauerbier, who changed his name to John Chris Aberfoyle on 12 September 1917. A section of the family moved to the Southern Vales, building two houses near Wickham Hill, on land formerly owned by Benjamin Wickham and Francis Grote.

The property `Aberfoyle' consists of the homestead and associated stable, barn and groomsman's quarters, as well as a number of other structures. The complex is strongly representative of a farming estate of the late 19th century. Associated with the buildings is a possible aboriginal scar tree and water soak. The house which is built into the hill is constructed of bluestone rubble with brick dressings, and is set over a substantial basement. The hipped roof incorporates a concave corrugated galvanized iron clad verandah which encircles the building. The cast iron enrichment to balustrading, spandrels and friezework, probably from Harley's Sun Foundry, may be of later date.

Integrity: The house has been little altered, although a portion of the verandah has been enclosed.. All buildings have deteriorated and some vandalism is evident. The complex is leased at the moment to two parties. It is threatened by future subdivisional pressures and natural forces.

155181 JOHN CHRISTIAN SAUERBIER (1856 - 1923) - A. K. A. John Chris ABERFOYLE

John Christian SAUERBIER was born at Happy Valley, South Australia on 4 September 1856. His father was Christian SAUERBIER (1814-1893), farmer of Happy Valley, and his mother was Margaret Ann SAUERBIER, nee TAPLEY (1825 - 1901). (1)

He became a farmer, and when his father died in 1893, he took over the Happy Valley farming property. (2)

He married later in life at the age of 43 in 1899, to Mabel Phoebe (May) KITHER, who was only aged 23 at this time. (3)

His mother died on 23 July 1901 at her sister's residence at Parkside, but gave her usual residence as Happy Valley, so was probably living with her son and daughter-in law normally.(4)

John Christian and May SAUERBIER had 3 daughters of their marriage, over the ensuing years-

1551811. Jean Margaret SAUERBIER, born 1902, at Happy Valley

1551812. Beryl May SAUERBIER, born 1905, at North Adelaide

1551813. Nancy SAUERBIER, born probably about 1908. (5)

During World War 1, when feelings ran high against German Families, even though they were born in Australia, John Christian changed his surname from SAUERBIER.

On 12 September 1917 he became known as John Chris ABERFOYLE, and the present day southern suburb of Aberfoyle Park is named after him and his property. (6)

John Christian SAUERBIER/ABERFOYLE, died at the age of 67 years in Adelaide, on 21 March 1923. (7)

He was survived by his wife Mabel Phoebe SAUERBIER/ABERFOYLE, and three daughters.

Mabel Phoebe KITHER was born on 4 March 1876, in South Australia, and was the third child of John Torraine KITHER (1848 - 1919), butcher of Glenelg, and Phoebe KITHER, nee FLEMING (1851 - 1914). (1)

May, as she was apparently known, married John Christian SAUERBIER in 1899, when she was aged 23 years. (2)

They lived at the Sauerbier Farm at Happy Valley, and had three daughters-

1. Jean Margaret born 1902 .
2. Beryl May born 1905.
3. Nancy born about 1907. (3)

The family changed their name in 1917, due to persecution, to the name ABERFOYLE. (4)

Her husband, John Christian SAUERBIER/ABERFOYLE died on 21 March 1923. (5)

Mabel Phoebe ABERFOYLE died at the age of 82 years on 8 April 1958. (6)

Little is known of her life, but she probably changed her surname to ABERFOYLE in 1917 as she was only 15 years old at the time.

Beryl May SAUERBIER was born at North Adelaide on 27 May 1905. Her father was John Christian SAUERBIER (1856 –1923), and her mother was Mabel Phoebe SAUERBIER, nee KITHER (1876-1955)

1551813 Nancy SAUERBIER /ABERFOYLE (c.1907 -)

Nancy SAUERBIER was born in 1908. Her father was John Christian SAUERBIER (1856 –1923), and her mother was Mabel Phoebe SAUERBIER, nee KITHER (1876-1955)

155182 JOHN JAMES SAUERBIER (1858 - 1938)

John James SAUERBIER was born at Happy Valley, South Australia on 10 February 1858. His father was Christian SAUERBIER (1814-1893), Farmer of Happy Valley, and his mother was Margaret Ann SAUERBIER, nee TAPLEY (1825-1901). (1)

John James grew up on the family farm at Happy Valley, and like his elder brother, he married later in life, at the age of 44.

John James SAUERBIER, married on 27 Feb 1902, to Mary Anne Louisa LOCKE, aged 21, at the Residence of J. J. PIKE at Brighton. (2)

They were to have 4 Children of their marriage over the next eleven years-

1551821. Kathleen Margaret SAUERBIER, born on 21 January 1903 at Brighton.

1551822. John Tapley SAUERBIER, born on 20 October 1907.

1551823. Louis Christian SAUERBIER, born on 22 May 1911.

1551824. Gladys Mary SAUERBIER, born on 1 September 1913. (3)

Over the years, they lived variously at Happy Valley, Malvern, and Lower Mitcham. (4)

When his brother changed his name in 1917 to ABERFOYLE, it seems that John James SAUERBIER declined to do the same.

John James SAUERBIER died at the age of 80 years on 19 September 1938, at Adelaide. He is buried at Brighton, South Australia.(5)

He was survived by his wife Mary Ann Louisa .
